WHEREAS, the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority is a participating agency under the Ocean County Co-Operative Pricing System known as ID#33-OCCP; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2018 Stafford Township, as the Lead Agency authorized their Business Administrator, in consultation with Concord Energy Services, to enter into a contract on behalf of the STCPS for the Supply and Delivery of Natural Gas by Resolution 2018-264; and

WHERERAS, Concord Energy Services is an approved on-line Purchasing Agent with the Department of Community Affairs E-Procurement Pilot Program for both on-line receipt of bids and reverse auctions; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2018 an on-line sealed bid for the Supply and Delivery of Natural Gas was conducted by Concord Energy Services; and

WHEREAS, Contract #33-OCCPS-2018-010 has been awarded by the Lead Agency to South Jersey Energy Company, 1300 Route 73 South, Suite 308, Mt. Laurel, NJ 08054; and

WHEREAS, the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority desires to join the above mentioned contract; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director recommends award of this contract by this Board of Commissioners.

- 4. That this shall be a thirty six (36) month contract beginning January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021 as awarded by the lead agency.
- 5. That the Executive Director is authorized to execute and the Assistant Secretary to attest to the proposed form of agreement aforesaid, which such agreement shall be available for public examination in the Office of the QPA during normal business hours.

WHEREAS, the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter "TRMUA"), County of Ocean, State of New Jersey has determined that an emergency exists with regard to the health and safety of the residents, ratepayers and the general population as well as the integrity of TRMUA sanitary sewer system as a result of a broken deep house lateral effecting #3170 Beachview Drive, creating an obstruction and impacting the sewers ability to convey wastewater potentially causing an overflow; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the broken lateral, emergency services were required to make repairs; and

WHEREAS, the TRMUA has determined that an imminent emergent condition exists and the emergency could not reasonably have been foreseen; and

WHEREAS, M.C. Messina, Inc. will supply the necessary labor, materials and equipment required to and repair and or replace the damaged lateral.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority that an emergency contract is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 to M.C. Messina, Inc. in an amount of \$33,866.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract is subject to a certification of the availability of funds.
